☐ The religious leaders referred to "Iran's main opposition, the Mujahedin-e-Khalq (MEK)," as "an inspiration to, and instrumental player in, the pro-democracy movement in Iran due to its commitment to freedom."
☐ In diametric opposition to the ruling theocracy, the group espouses a tolerant and egalitarian Islam, which advocates gender equality and equality before the law for all religious and ethnic minorities.
☐ MEK seeks a non-nuclear Iran, at peace with all its neighbors.
Over 100 bipartisan Members of the House of Representatives, and other prominent American politicians, in unison with 3500 Parliamentarians and the highest courts in Europe, have conveyed the message that we should remove the MEK from the State Department's Foreign Terrorist Organizations list.
☐ This designation provides the Iranian government with the justification to commit heinous atrocities.
